<u>Title:</u> Inclement Weather and Toxicology Testing

Guideline:

- 1. If the collection site is closed due to inclement weather, the participant is excused once the agreement monitor has confirmed that the site was closed.
- 2. If the participant informs CCMP that s/he cannot test due to inclement weather (and the collection site is not closed), the participant may use one of the five toxicology exemptions allotted to each participant per year if the participant has been in compliance with all requirements for a period of nine consecutive months. If a participant is within the first year of the program, they are allotted three exemption days after nine months of compliance. This follows the toxicology testing guideline.
- 3. If the participant fails to inform CCMP of the failure to test due to inclement weather, the missed test is considered non-compliance.
- 4. If the participant informs CCMP of the failure to test due to inclement weather and does not meet the criteria for an exemption (and the collection site is not closed), the missed test is reported to Christiana Care Employee Health.
- 5. If the participant has less than nine months in the program and has been compliant but informs CCMP that the participant cannot test due to inclement weather, the participant in this situation will be granted a one-time use of one of the three toxicology exemptions allotted the first year to each participant.
